Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Mukhtiar Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.133 dated 07.11.2013 at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa under Section 306 IPC.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that as a consequence of orders of this Court dated 01.02.2017 the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail, and has placed on record copy of orders dated 07.02.2016 (sic) which is not controverted by learned State counsel.

In the light of the same, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.02.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
