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**MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (ORAL)**

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This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.111 dated 06.03.2009, under Sections 341, 323, 427 read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala District Patiala, on the basis of compromise entered between the parties on 08.02.2016 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 19.07.2017, the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the learned trial Court. In compliance thereof, the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala has submitted its report which inter alia stipulates that the above said compromise has been effected between the parties without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection for quashing the FIR.

In view of the above, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and that is not only for the betterment of warring groups, but a semblance for the growth of society. Consequently, this Court is satisfied that it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR as well as proceedings resulting therefrom.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. FIR No.111 dated 06.03.2009, under Sections 341, 323, 506 read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala District Patiala along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
