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The present writ petition is by M/s Subhash Pipes Ltd against the award dated 15.5.2001 passed by Labour Court-II, Faridabad wherein respondent workman-Mohmad Daud was ordered to be reinstatement into service with 50% back wages. The case file shows that no stay was granted by this Court. Subsequently, on an application that the respondent-workman has been reinstated into service, and as such, the payment of back wages in terms of the impugned award of the Labour Court be stayed, the request was declined.

Today learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he tried to contact the petitioner-Management but they are not responding and the case be consigned to the record-room at this stage.

In the aforesaid circumstances, we consider it appropriate at this stage to order consignment of the record of the case to record-room with liberty to the parties to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
