The allegations against petitioner-Pargat Singh in this anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C are that the petitioner by forging the signatures of complainant-Jagsir Singh sold his car Swift Dezire bearing registration number PB03-8811 model 2012.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is a friend of the complainant and there is a dispute between them and that nothing is to be recovered from him

The same is sought to be opposed by the learned State counsel assisted by Mr.B.S.Jatana, Advocate on the grounds that being a serious offence petitioners' custodial interrogation is very much essential for the entire investigation of the offence. Appreciating the submissions, keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations made by the complainant that the petitioner has not only forged his signatures but has even duped the public

authorities and his custodial interrogation is certainly essential to unearth the nexus and the manner of the same as well as participation of others in this crime.

Thus no cause for intervention is made out by this Court. The petition stands dismissed accordingly.
