In FIR No.151 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 302, 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 29.03.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
