The present petition has been filed under Section 438
the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 26 dated
18.02.2017 registered under Sections 306 IPC at Police Station
Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural.

On 30.03.2017 this Court had passed the following
order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioners have been falsely
implicated in the present case being relatives of co-accused,
namely, Satbir Kaur who is wife of the deceased. The cause of
suicide in fact, was primarily a matrimonial dispute between the
deceased and his wife Satbir Kaur who is residing abroad and had
refused to join his company. Petitioner No.1, namely, Mohinder
Kaur @ Mindo is bed ridden and is of more than 70 years of age.

Notice of motion for 04.05.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioners by the Arresting
Officer, they shall be released on interim bail subject to the

following conditions:-

- 1.That they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2.That they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
- 3.That they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 30.03.2017, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 30.03.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioners to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
