FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that on 14.08.2016 two DBBL .12 bore guns were recovered from the petitioner and it subsequently transpired that he has purchased the same illegally from the persons, who have earlier looted the gun house during the *Jaat* agitation.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is behind the bars from the day of his arrest and, thus, has undergone substantial incarceration is stoutly opposed by the learned State counsel on the grounds that allegations are serious in nature as the petitioner was in possession of stolen property.

Appreciating the submissions, in view of the period of incarceration of about 09 months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of

the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
