Allegations against the petitioner Nahnu in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.1017 dated 07.11.2016 registered at Police Station Jhajjar under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, are that on 07.11.2016, 1.50 kg Ganja, a non-commercial quantity of contraband, was recovered from the petitioner leading to his arrest.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is in custody since a long time and that trial is not likely to conclude in the near future.

Learned State counsel has sought to stoutly oppose grant of bail to the petitioner, however, having regard to the quantity of contraband recovered and without feeling necessity to advert on to the

merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that culpability if any shall be determined at the time of trial which will take long time to conclude thus, further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
