The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of two FIRs namely FIR No.407 dated 12.08.2013 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 506 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC and FIR No.92 dated 19.01.2017 registered under Section 341, 427, 506 IPC both at Police Station Sector 5, District Gurgaon, in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for complainants submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 30.03.2017 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and

genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court in both the FIRs and separate reports have been received by this Court. Looking to the reports it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioners. Looking to the nature of the offences I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-10877 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIRs namely FIR No.407 dated 12.08.2013 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 506 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 5, District Gurgaon
and
FIR No.92 dated 19.01.2017 registered under Section 341, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Sector 5, District Gurgaon, are quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua the petitioners.
