Learned counsel for both the parties have stated that all the
retiral dues have been paid to the petitioner during the pendency of the
present writ petition. However, learned counsel for the petitioner presses for
the interest on the delayed payment stating that the payments of retiral
benefits were became due to the petitioner w.e.f. 22.04.1988 but the same
were released after about eight years.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a
direction to the respondents to release the payment of interest on the delayed
payment of retiral benefits of the husband of the petitioner @ 9% per annum
starting three months from 22.04.1988, the date from which the husband of
the petitioner got missing till the actual payment within two months from the
date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
