On 30.3.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner
contends that the petitioner and his father are not
described by their nicknames in the FIR. The
presumption has been drawn by the trial Court while
dismissing the anticipatory bail that petitioner might
be having nickname of Shalu and father of the*

petitioner might be having nickname of Bhim Raj.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the aforesaid opinion is totally based on conjectures.

Notice of motion for 26.05.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 05.04.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. “

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh, while admitting the said fact, has submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer even by admitting that petitioner and his father are not described by their nick names in the FIR. He relied upon the affidavit submitted by the villagers to contend that in fact petitioner and his father are the persons known by their

names as disclosed in the FIR.

I have no doubt that the police would investigate on the aforesaid premise in accordance with law.

In view of aforesaid, interim order dated 30.3.2017 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
