In FIR No.1022 dated 05.11.2016 registered under Sections 304/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Jind, District-Jind the petitioner is in custody since 06.11.2016.

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner-Sandeep had arrived near the stationery car in which the deceased-Kaptan Singh was sitting and having conversation with the deceased by standing outside the car from the window and in the meanwhile started playing with the revolver belonging to Jasbir, who has been released on bail granted by the trial Court. The revolver accidentally got fired, in the result Kaptan Singh has died as per the disclosure statement of the petitioner-Sandeep.

The trial court has granted bail to Jasbir Singh, thus there is a prima facie case for grant of bail to the petitioner-Sandeep. In that view of the matter, petition for bail is allowed. The petitioner-Sandeep is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
