Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 02.10.2016, upon a non-commercial quantity of '*Charas*' having been recovered from him and with the trial having just gone underway and 10 witnesses still remaining to be examined.

Learned State counsel does not deny the aforesaid facts and on query, further submits that there is no other case registered against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that the trial is likely to take long as yet, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, further subject to the condition that he would continue to appear before that Court as and when summoned by it.
