After arguing this case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with the request that the trial be ordered to be concluded within specified period.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagbir Singh submits that out of total ten prosecution witnesses, one prosecution witness has been examined and two prosecution witnesses have been left out as unnecessary and 19.04.2017 is the date fixed for further prosecution evidence.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to direct the trial Court to conclude the case preferably within a period of 6 months from the next date of hearing. If the trial is not concluded within specified period, in that eventuality, petitioner may approach the Court of Sessions for seeking bail in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
