Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.78 dated 27.12.2015, under Sections 302/307/34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Khilchian, District Amritsar.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Sukhjinder Singh in relation to an occurrence dated 26.12.2015 and in which one Amritpal Singh received a gunshot injury.

It has gone uncontroverted that the solitary gunshot injury suffered by deceased Amritpal Singh is attributed to co-accused Ravinderpal Singh. Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, he has been attributed a gunshot injury on injured Gurpreet Singh and which hit him on the hips.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 12.02.2016.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Charanjit

Singh would apprise the Court that all the material witnesses have already been examined.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
