SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

Petitioner was named as an accused in the original FIR but in the challan his name was not sent up for trial as the Police found no material against him. However, during trial the complainant again made incriminating statement against the petitioner, on account of which, a subsequent application to implead him as an additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C., was allowed by the Trial Court.

[2]. The petitioner has challenged the impugned order vide **CRR-317-2017** which is stated to be fixed for 14.09.2017, and the said order is also stated to have been stayed. Other accused persons in the case are, admittedly, on bail.

[3]. For these reasons, this Court finds no reason to detain the petitioner when trial is actually in progress.

[4]. In these circumstance, the interim bail granted to the petitioner on the last date, is, hereby, confirmed.
