This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of 'regular bail' in case FIR No.113 dated 14.09.2015 (Annexure P-1), registered for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 302, 452, 34 IPC, at police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has actually been roped in, being the son of Salwinder Singh and the younger brother of Gursahib Singh, who have each been attributed an injury to the deceased. He further submits that the petitioner is only 23 years old and is in custody since 30.12.2015.

While placing on record the custody certificate of the petitioner, learned State counsel submits that though injuries have been attributed to the petitioner, but no specific injury has been attributed to him, though he along with his co-accused father and brother, attacked deceased Balbir Singh.

Considering the aforesaid, but without commenting on the actual merits of the case, as one injury each was attributed to the father and

brother of the petitioner, which eventually led to the death of Balbir Singh, the present petition is allowed subject to the petitioner furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
