Challenge in the present petition is to the award dated 7.5.1998, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Hissar in a reference under Sections 18 and 30 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

At the very out-set, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Sita Ram, Patwari, office of Land acquisition Collector, Hissar, submitted that the land, grievance of which has been raised by the petitioner in para No. 2 of the petition, was not finally acquired, hence, the dispute pertaining to compensation or apportionment thereof does not survive.

Considering the stand taken by learned counsel for the State, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous and

the same is disposed of accordingly.
