The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 483 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the entire proclamation including the mode and manner of the issuance of warrants of arrest issued against him as well as setting aside of the impugned order dated 26.05.2005 passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-11) in case arising out of FIR No.55 dated 18.03.1989 registered under Sections 5, 3, 47 of the Prevention of Corruption Act and Section 163 and 420 IPC at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner has been declared a Proclaimed Offender.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This Court had made order dated 25.07.2017 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report, it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioner. Looking to the nature of the offence, I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRM-M-11060-2015 is allowed, subject to payment of ₹10,000/- (non-refundable), payable to SSP, Tarn Taran within four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
- (ii) The FIR No.55 dated 18.03.1989 registered under Sections 5, 3, 47 of the Prevention of Corruption Act and Section 163 and 420 IPC at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-2) and order dated 26.05.2005, whereby the petitioner has been declared a Proclaimed Offender, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua the petitioner.
