The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of criminal complaint No.21 dated 15.04.2011 under Sections 166/499/500/34 of IPC titled Satender Singh Vs. Anju Yadav as well as the summoning order dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P-5) issued by the trial Court.

Petitioner also assails the order dated 06.12.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by the revisional Court upholding the impugned summoning order.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition.

Prayer is allowed.

The present petition is disposed of as withdrawn. It is, however, clarified that withdrawal of the instant petition would not preclude the petitioner from raising all submissions/contentions as may be available to her in accordance with law before the trial Court.
