Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

There is a fervent request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner to release the petitioner on bail, in view of the fact that petitioner is suffering from HIV positive and hepatitis C.

I have seen the medical record produced by the learned State counsel. The record shows that the petitioner is suffering from both as above. Though, the petitioner has made every ground to get release on bail, but I do not think that he should be released on bail since he is suffering from HIV positive and upon release on bail, he is likely to put his family in danger conditions. In that view of the matter, only way out is to direct the trial Court to complete the trial within the stipulated period. The special reason is the petitioner being the patient suffering from serious diseases. This Court would justify in asking the

trial Court to complete the trial within the stipulated period looking to the peculiar facts that the petitioner has been in jail since 08.05.2016 and coupled with above medical records.

In that view of the matter, this petition is dismissed. Trial Court is directed to complete the trial in any case before 30.08.2017 including deliverance of judgment. The trial Court shall not adjourn the case rather take on day to day basis. If the trial is not completed by the said date, the matter would be viewed seriously. Prosecutor is directed to inform the order to the trial Court, accordingly.
