Learned State counsel, who is on instructions from S.I Tarsem Singh would very fairly states that main accused Lalit Kumar as also other co-accused namely Mangat Ram and Kamal Kumar and against whom there were similar allegations as the present petitioner, have been granted benefit of bail by this Court.

As per statement and stand taken on behalf of the State and on the ground of parity itself the present petitioner is held entitled to the concession of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.270 dated 4.5.2014 under sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 341, 307, 302 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, City Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.
