Prayer is for bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No. 23 dated 11.02.2004 registered under Sections 498A, 494, 420, 406, 120B IPC at Police Station City Kotkapura.

It is informed that eight (8) out of nineteen (19) prosecution witnesses have been examined. The matter is now listed before the learned trial Court for 26.05.2017 for recording of rest of the prosecution evidence. The petitioner admittedly absented herself from trial for nearly nine years. Due to this reason, I do not find any ground for affording the concession of bail pending trial to the petitioner, at this stage. However, the learned trial Court is directed to conclude the proceedings in this matter expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months.

Petition is disposed of, accordingly.
