Though learned counsel for the State has presented a document said to be a report of a special investigating team headed by the S.P. Investigation, Moga, it not being accompanied by any affidavit, is not taken on record.

However, learned State counsel submits that as per investigation conducted so far, there was no communication between the petitioner and Gurwinder Singh @ Gori, who allegedly had informed the petitioner that he would be getting some relatives to his house and the petitioner on the faith of that statement had allowed such persons to come to his house, thinking that they were relatives of Gurwinder Singh @ Gori, allegedly not knowing that they were escaped convicts.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel and seriousness of the issue, I see no reason to continue the interim order dated 06.04.2017.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed and the interim order dated 06.04.2017 is vacated. However, nothing stated herein above would be taken an observation by this Court on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner.
