In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.6-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala is directed to decide the complaint/representation dated 14.02.2017 (Annexures P-2), by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
