Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.02 dated 04.01.2017 under Sections 22/25 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is 10 vials of COREX and 100 tablets ALPAX of 0.5 mg.

Petitioner was arrested on 04.01.2017.

It has gone uncontroverted that the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as non-commercial.

Investigation is complete. Challan has been presented and even charges have been framed on 29.03.2017.

Trial is at the initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other proceedings under the NDPS Act.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held

entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
