**INDERJIT SINGH, J.**

Petitioner-Gurwinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.200 dated 29.10.2016, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC and Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the present petitioner alongwith other persons has taken the amount of ₹68

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lakhs approximately from so many persons by inducing them for selecting in the army, bank etc. There is allegation that ₹6,50,000/- have been deposited in the account of the petitioner by the complainant party.

The petitioner has been in custody since 29.10.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Moreover, all the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
