This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for granting regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 93 dated 21.5.2015 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 376-D, 511, 506, 307 IPC and Section 3 of SCs and STs (Prevention of Atrocities Act) and 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Chhappar, District Yamuna Nagar.

As per the allegations in the FIR, petitioner along with his friends came to the house of complainant-Kajal and attempted to commit rape upon her. However, the injuries of knife has been attributed to the complainant by Kinnu s/o Kanwar Pal.

Learned counsel for State has informed that out of 16 witnesses, 7 witnesses have been examined and application moved under Section 319 Cr. P.C. was dismissed on 12.1.2017.

Keeping in view the role of the petitioner in the FIR and considering the fact that trial would take long time to its own conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail subject to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.

Disposed of accordingly.
