Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.23, dated 23.02.2016, registered under Sections 193, 196, 198, 420, 467, 468, 471 (Section 120-B added later on) of IPC, at Police Station Women Palwal, District Palwal.

Vide order dated 17.01.2017, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated; he has already joined investigation and cooperated with the police and no recovery from him is to be made.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Davinder Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and at this stage is not needed by the investigating agency for further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated

17.01.2017 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing observed herein above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this court on the merits of the case.
