FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that on 1.12.2016 he along with principal accused Prabhjot Singh, who had a matrimonial dispute which has led to divorce with Kamaljit Kaur, daughter of the complainant Chamkaur Singh came in a car and assaulted the family of the complainant leading to fracture to leg of Rajinder Kaur and injuries to others.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that medical evidence reflects only grievous injuries and that the petitioner is in custody since 3.12.2016.

The bail application is opposed by the learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant on the grounds that

it was on account of grudge the petitioner had tried to take law in his own hand and that if allowed bail he will again assault the complainant side.

Appreciating the submissions and keeping in view that the petitioner is in custody since 3.12.2016 and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
