Petitioner-Rajesh Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 by this Court vide order dated 07.11.2016 passed in CRM-M-33903-2016 in FIR No.94 dated 02.08.2016, registered at Police Station Mataur, SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 406, 420, 465, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

At the time of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner argued that six months have passed and process of refund of money for tickets has not been completed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that this Court has granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner without imposing any condition qua the process of refund of money etc., I do not find any ground to cancel the anticipatory bail granted

to respondent No.2-Yaman Sharma vide order dated 07.11.2016. Nothing has been argued that respondent No.2 has violated any terms and conditions of the anticipatory bail or has misused the concession of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
