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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.116 dated 13.10.2016 registered under Sections 307, 336, 148 & 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Muktsar Sahib.

There are 11 accused persons in all in this FIR. I have perused the FIR. The FIR shows that all the accused persons were carrying deadly weapons in respect of which ultimately investigation started in October, 2016.

Learned State counsel submits that investigation is still going on and she opposed the request for compromise/compounding.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that indeed the compromise has taken place because both the parties belong to the same village and want to live amicably and peacefully.

Looking to the fact that the petitioner has been granted interim bail vide order dated 06.02.2017 and the matter has been compromised as stated by learned counsel for the parties, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-1142 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not temper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition, the present order shall come to an end and the petitioners shall surrender to the judicial custody.
