Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite an order of status quo having been passed by this Court on 21.10.2016 in Civil Revision No.6971 of 2016, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-1 with the petition, and the revenue record stating that the petitioner and his co-sharers are in possession of the land, respondents no.6 to 8 allegedly are not allowing the petitioner to harvest the crop standing on the land. The said respondents are stated to be vendees of certain shares of the land from co-sharers of the land.

However, no copy of the 'jamabandi/khasra girdawari' has been actually placed on record to show actual possession as per the revenue record.

Learned counsel submits that at this stage he would be satisfied with the petition being disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani (respondent no.4), to look into the matter and decide the petitioners' representation stated to have been made to him on 27.03.2017 (Annexure P-3), as the crop is now ready for harvesting.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual possession on the spot, which would obviously be reflected in the revenue record, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani, (respondent no.4), to look into the matter and take a decision on the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a one week from today, in view of the fact that the harvesting season is obviously ongoing.

A copy of this order be given to the learned counsel for the petitioner under signatures of the Special Secretary of the Bench.
