This is a petition filed by the petitioner seeking permission to visit Saudi Arabia to perform Haj.

The petitioner was arrested in case FIR No.92 dated 15.6.2016 registered for offence punishable under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at PS City-1, Malerkotla. He is on anticipatory bail in this case and has surrendered before the police and joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel has submitted that there were other FIRs against the petitioner also which have either been cancelled or quashed.

Case against the petitioner is based on documentary evidence. He has sought permission to go for Haj during the period from 1.8.2017 to 30.9.2017.

Permission as sought is allowed.

The passport of the petitioner has not been issued by the passport authorities due to the registration of this FIR against him.

In view of the permission allowed to him, the required passport be issued to the petitioner. However, before going abroad, the petitioner will intimate the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur and furnish surety bond of ₹ 10 lac. He will intimate that on which date he will leave the country and return.

The petition stands disposed of in above terms.
