The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.684 dated 31.12.2016 under Sections 148/149/323/341/506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had given a farsa (sharp edged) blow on the head of Isriel, although injury which has been found on the head of Isriel is a lacerated wound. He further states that FIR was lodged after three days of the occurrence. He also contends that FIR is an outcome of a quarrel between the neighbours and with the intervention of respectables, the matter has been compromised. The copy of compromise is annexed as Anneuxre P-1.

This Court, by the order dated 29.08.2017 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ranbir Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 29.08.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 29.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
