The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.100 dated 06.08.2016, registered under Sections 326/324/325/34 IPC at Police Station Dhariwal, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that in respect of occurrence dated 18.04.2016, the FIR in question came to be registered only on 06.08.2016. Though there was some typographical error in the translated version of the FIR, but the factum of injury attributed to the petitioners was duly noticed in the order passed by the Court of Sessions.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation in pursuance of order dated 17.01.2017 and recoveries have been effected. Petitioners are no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, interim order dated 17.01.2017 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
