The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.109 dated 06.12.2014, registered under Sections 302 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Gurdaspur.

Contents that this is the third bail petition, whereas, the second one was dismissed on the ground that the trial is at the fag end.

Similar statement is being made by learned State counsel today as well. The case is now slated for arguments on 30.08.2017.

Heard.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, the Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the present petition.

Dismissed.
