Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Nirmal @ Kalu in case registered by way of FIR No.475 dated 24.12.2016 at Police Station Civil Lines, District Kaithal under Sections 21/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 03.04.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Rajbir Singh from Police Station Civil Lines, Kaithal who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.04.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
