Petitioners have filed this petition for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their lives and personal liberties from being invaded at the instance of respondents No. 4 to 8, who are the family members of Kavita Verma, with whom son of petitioners No. 1 and 2, namely Sunil Kumar, was married. Kavita Verma and Sunil Kumar filed CRM-M No. 10217 of 2017, which was decided by the High Court on 24.03.2017. Thereafter, the representation of aforesaid Kavita Verma and Sunil Kumar was decided by the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, and they are living in Protection Home. In continued grudge on account of the aforesaid marriage, the petitioners feel reasonable

apprehension from respondents No. 4 to 8 and precisely for the grievance in question, they have already moved a representation before respondent No. 2 on 30.03.2017.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ripudaman, A.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner in context of her representation dated 30.03.2017. If some cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then respondent No. 4 can be asked to act in accordance with law. If no substance is found in the allegations of the petitioner, then the petitioner can be informed in view of parameters as laid down in **Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC (1)**.
