Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.322 dated 24.09.2015, registered under Sections 302, 450 and 120-B I.P.C. at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that

co-accused, namely Rahul, Vinod Kumar and Sanjay Raheja, have already been granted regular bail by this Court on 16.03.2017.

Petitioner was arrested on 16.12.2015 and on his disclosure statement, other co-accused were arrested. Petitioner was one of the persons, who stood outside the house along with Sanjay Raheja and Vinod Kumar.

The role of petitioner cannot be segregated from that of co-accused Sanjay Raheja and Vinod Kumar, who have already been granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satpal submitted that role of the petitioner is at par with co-accused Sanjay Raheja and Vinod Kumar.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, it would be just and expedient to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail, subject to his furnishing heavy bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed

to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
