Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.157 dated 23.12.2016 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 17.01.2017, this Court while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim protection to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has paid ₹2,40,000/- to the complainant against the cheque amount of ₹3,00,000/-.

Learned State Counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that as against the cheque amount, substantial amount has been paid by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 17.01.2017 is made absolute, subject to the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
