Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.264 dated 19.12.2011 registered under Sections 420, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC added later), at Police Station City Ferozepur, on the basis of compromise dated 10.09.2014 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 28.08.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate, Ferozepur, to get their statements recorded qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties also whether any accused was declared as proclaimed offender.

Consequently, complainant Tehal Singh (respondent No.2 herein) and petitioner-Parminder Kaur appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur, on 06.09.2017 and got recorded their statements qua compromise. Report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide her covering letter bearing No.669 dated 18.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ferozepur vide letter bearing No.9070/CB dated 20.09.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur, the compromise between the parties appears to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion and pressure. Further, as per report, accused Sachin Kumar and Vikas Sharma are proclaimed offenders.

Earlier, this very F.I.R. against co-accused Daler Singh, Harnek Singh and Radhika, has also been quashed vide order dated 27.05.2014 passed in CRM-M-35510 of 2012 and CRM-M-669 of 2013.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.264, is hereby quashed qua the petitioner Parminder Kaur only.
