Though the petitioner was on bail earlier pursuant to FIR No.73 dated 20.2.2012 registered against him for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 420 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City, thereafter he not having answered the summons of the Court and the warrants issued thereafter, proclamation was issued under Section 82 Cr.P.C. and eventually he was declared to be a proclaimed person on 14.3.2016.

In the aforesaid circumstances, I see no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail. The petition is consequently dismissed.

However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and filing a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for 'regular bail', it would be decided at the earliest by that Court, on its own merits.
