Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have married each other against the wishes of their parents and on account of this act on their part, they are under threat of being eliminated at the hands of the private respondents. Seeking protection of their life and liberty, the present petition has been filed.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3.

Mr. Surinder Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has supplied a complete set of paper book to learned counsel for respondent No.1.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the matter, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3-the Station House Officer, Police Station Bhuna, Tehsil and District Fatehabad, Haryana within two days from today who is directed to consider their grievance made by them before him and thereafter forthwith take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

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It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged marriage of the petitioners or to protect them from any illegal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
