This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to protect the property of Truck Union; to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and the members of the Truck Union; and to register a criminal case against the unscrupulous/Gunda elements, who are threatening the petitioner as well as the truck operators to involve them in some false cases.

The learned Senior counsel states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to treat the present petition as representation of the petitioner and decide the same.

In these circumstances, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to treat the present petition as representation of the petitioner and decide the same, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and provide necessary protection to the petitioner, in accordance with law.
