By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.115 dated 22.06.2016, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later on), at Police Station Samrala, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Contents that co-accused, Devinder Singh @ Gaga and Palakdeep Kaur have been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 25.10.2016 (Annexure P-4). No specific injury is attributed to the petitioner. Initially the FIR was registered under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC. Subsequently, on receipt of report of the doctor, Section 307 IPC has been added.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel vehemently opposes the present petition and states that due to the impact of the injury, the injured has slipped into coma and is still in a vegetative state. Photographs of the injured were also circulated during the course of arguments.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the entire record on file.

Considering the nature of the injury suffered by the injured, whose age is 25 years and the fact that due to these injuries, he has slipped into coma, no case for bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
