The instant writ petition was instituted in the year 1997 seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondent authorities to appoint them as Head Constables in C-2 List as maintained under the Punjab Police Rules.

Mr. Chandi Ram Sharma, Advocate who filed the writ petition is stated to be no more. Accordingly, notices were issued to the petitioners herein who are 17 in number.

As per office report, notices stand duly served upon petitioner Nos.1 to 7 and 9 to 17. Petitioner No.8 is stated to have expired.

No appearance has been caused today on behalf of petitioner Nos.2 to 7 and 9 to 17 in spite of having been duly served.

Petitioner No.1, namely, Sukhjeet Singh has appeared in person

and makes a statement that he is not interested in pursuing the instant

petition as he had attained the age of superannuation more than 03 years back.

Under such circumstances, the only inference that can be drawn that even the other petitioners are not inclined to pursue the instant petition.

Petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner Nos.2 to 7, 9 to 17 as also to the legal heirs of petitioner No.08 to file an appropriate application for revival of the petition and by demonstrating that any cause of action still survives.
