The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in the event of arrest, in FIR No. 49 dated 07.02.2017, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

During the pendency of the instant petition, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement and the same has been successful. A settlement agreement has been entered into between the parties and in terms of the said settlement, the parties have decided to part ways by obtaining a decree of divorce on the basis of the mutual consent. It has also

been agreed that respondent-wife would withdraw all pending litigation against the petitioner including proceedings filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and Domestic Violence Act. There has been part compliance of the settlement so arrived at between the parties.

In view of above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 06.04.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438, Sub Section (2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
