On 06.04.2017, following order was passed by this

Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner

contends that FIR No.62 was registered on

02.08.2015 under Sections 399, 402, 382, 379

IPC and under Section 25/27 of the Arms Act,

Police Station Kot Dharmu, District Mansa on the basis of secret information to the effect that accused were roaming freely in a car and were making preparation to commit a major incident of robbery/dacoity. No particulars of planning as to the target which was sought to be planned by the accused came to fore. Petitioner was never sought to be arrested, nor was declared as proclaimed offender till date. Even co-accused Amrinder Singh was granted regular bail by the court of Sessions on 31.05.2016.

Notice of motion for 24.05.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 11.04.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall

*abide by the conditions incorporated under
Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance of order dated 06.04.2017.

The aforesaid fact has not been denied by learned State counsel on instructions from A.S.I. Harinder Pal Singh and she further submitted that the petitioner is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, interim order dated 06.04.2017 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
