Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.48 dated 05.02.2017, under Section 379-B of IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Police Commissionerate, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ashish Pathak. Allegations are that on 05.02.2017 while the complainant along with his wife Priya Sharma were proceeding on a scooter, one boy came on an Activa scooter bearing No. PB-02-CW-8263 wearing a cap and snatched the purse from Priya Sharma. It is alleged that the purse contained Rs.8500/-, one mobile of Vivo Company and certain other domestic articles.

Even though the name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR yet he has been implicated on the basis that the Activa Scooter named by the complainant is in his ownership.

As per prosecution version, the purse in question, the mobile of

Petitioner was arrested on 06.02.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan already stands presented.

Charges are yet to be framed.

The petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other criminal proceedings.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
